## STAYING IN THE KNOW...

**Please make note of the following:**

1. Off-campus lunch privilege is not automatically bestowed upon students. Students must apply for off-campus lunch privilege in the 2nd semester of their 3rd year in high school. Students who have not applied and received permission, but qualify for the privilege, may not leave campus unless a parent/legal guardian has signed them out of school. If a junior or senior removes an underclassmen from campus, then he/she will lose their on campus parking privileges for the remainder of the school year. Additionally, students are not allowed to enter the visitor's parking area (in the front of the school), nor are they allowed to loiter in the student parking areas (C & D lots).
  2. Parents, please be aware that our front parking area is now designated for visitor's. All lined parking spaces, except for those with a sign-post, are visitor's spaces.
- This includes all spaces along the white curb (including those marked "faculty"). Please do not park along the yellow curb, since this area is restricted for emergency access.
3. The Exit Exam, or HSAP, will be given April 21, 22, and 23. All second year students will be taking it for the first time during this administration. Any third or fourth year students new to SC public schools, or any students who have taken it in the past and been unsuccessful on either the English or Math portion, will also test. Students are required to pass both the two day English portion, and the one day Math portion of the Exit Exam to receive a high school diploma in South Carolina. Anyone with any questions about the Exit Exam should call Rob Herron, Assistant Principal, at 699-2999, ext. 225.
  4. Rising 9th grade registration will begin on March 27th. Appointment times typically have ranged from 2:15-8:00 PM. Parents are strongly encouraged to come to their child's appointment. Registering at the school will give parents an opportunity to choose their child's courses and leave with an actual schedule in hand. To help parents better understand the courses for which their children have been recommended, and to help in building a schedule, we are having a parents' night on Thursday, April 23rd at 6:30 PM in the Ridge View Auditorium. This meeting will give parents the opportunity to work with a Guidance Counselor, the Magnet Director, the Schools-Within-a-School Directors, the Lead Teachers for the Blazer Academy, and upperclassmen, all of whom will be there to help parents make informed choices and build better schedules for their children.
